## Grants Awarded

<b>FY17 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs— Bulletproof Vest Partnership</b>	Awarded \$9,225.79. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests. Must exhaust FY17 funds prior to drawing down FY18 funds.
<b>FY18 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership</b>	On October 3, 2018, awarded \$19,148.75. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests.
<b>FY17 Board of State and Community Corrections</b>	Grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 was awarded in February 2017. Grant funds are being used to provide additional staffing to expand the Department's Mental Health Evaluation Team in coordination with the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health. Our Mental Health Evaluation Team coordinates and collaborates with several local mental health providers to assist with and to provide additional outreach services for our mental health/homeless contacts.
<b>FY19 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)</b>	Awarded \$120,000 on October 1, 2018. The grant period is October 1, 2018- September 30, 2019. The First Quarter Program and Financial/Reimbursement reports are due by January 30, 2019. Grant funds are used to continue Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations, Traffic Safety Educational Presentations and Safe Routes to School education and enforcement.

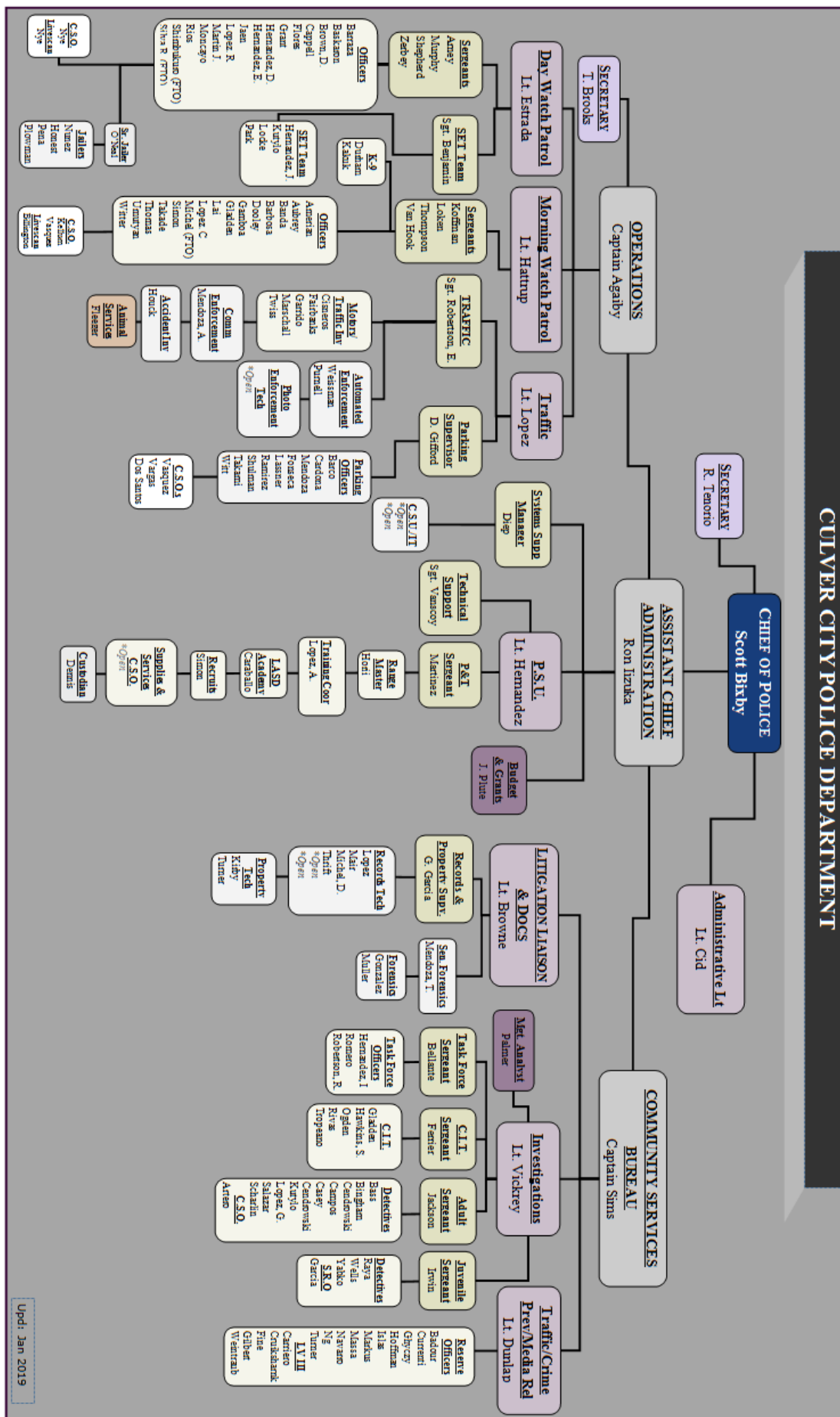
## Grants Closed

<b>FY16 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership</b>	Grant period ended on September 20, 2018. Reimbursement requests are still being processed.
<b>FY18 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)</b>	The grant period ended on September 30, 2018. On October 16, 2018 submitted the Final Financial/Reimbursement Report and the final Program Report.

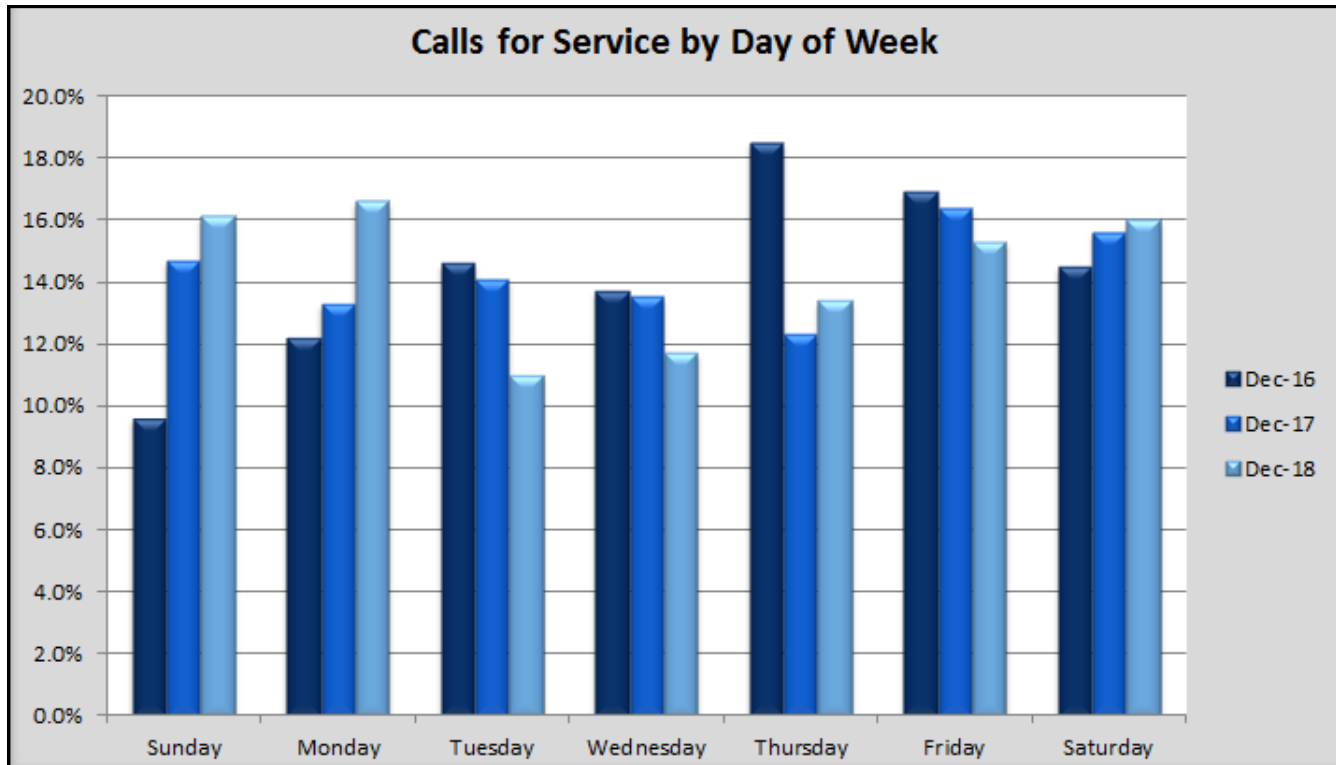

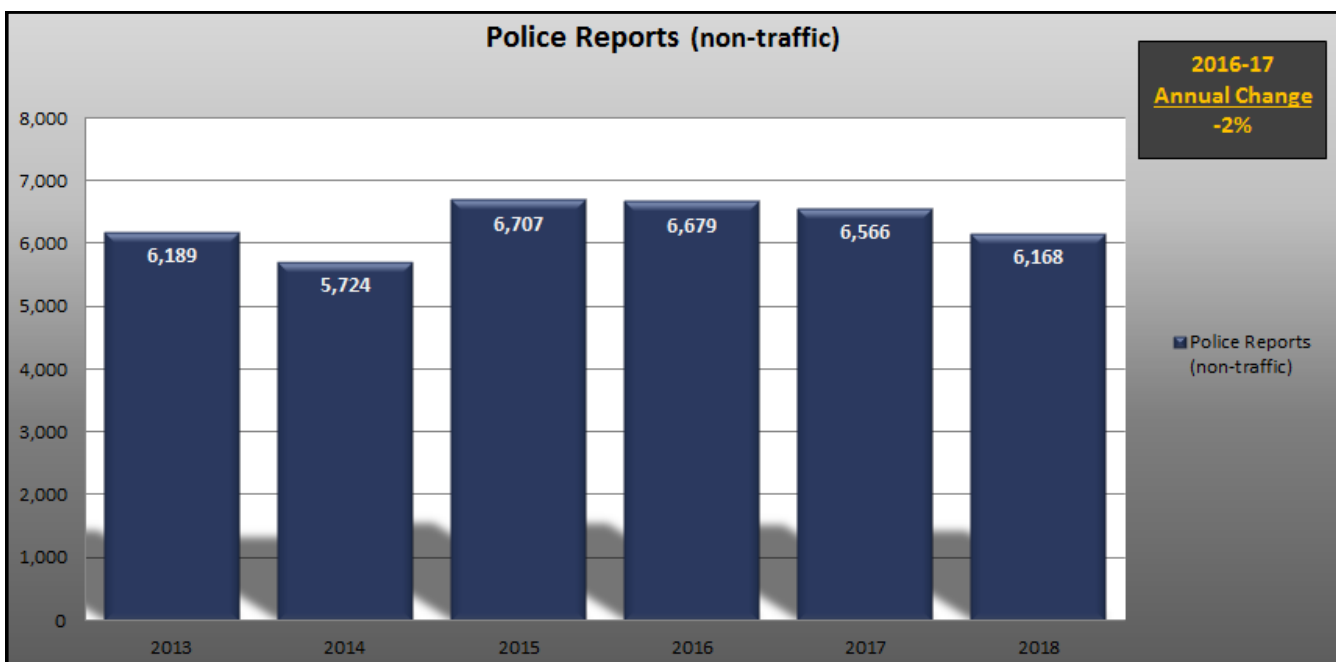


## CALLS FOR SERVICE BY DAY OF WEEK

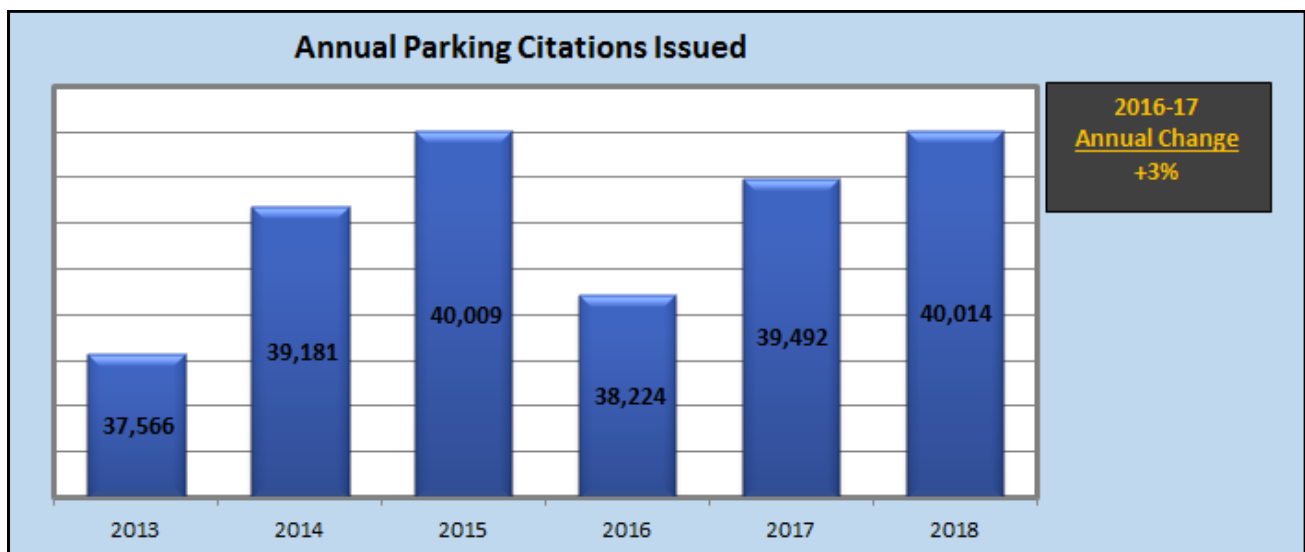
