### Grants Awarded

<b>FY16 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership</b>	Awarded \$22,505.08. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests. Required to exhaust FY16 funds prior to using FY17 funds.
<b>FY17 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs—Bulletproof Vest Partnership</b>	Awarded \$9,225.79. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests.
<b>FY17 Board of State and Community Corrections</b>	Grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 was awarded in February 2017. Grant funds will be used to contract with local non-profit social service providers to perform additional outreach services for our homeless population and interface with our mental health evaluation team for the best possible solutions for each individual case.
<b>FY18 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)</b>	FY18 Grant in the amount of \$120,000 was awarded on August 25, 2017. The grant period is October 1, 2017- September 30, 2018. First Quarter Program and Financial/ Reimbursement reports are due by January 30, 2018. Requested grant funds will continue Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations, Traffic Safety Educational Presentations and Safe Routes to School education and enforcement.

<b>FY16 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program – Local Solicitation</b>	Grant period ended on September 30, 2017. Grant funds covered the costs to create a law enforcement strategic plan for police leadership to advance the department's ability to deliver the highest quality service to the community. The grant period is October 1, 2015-September 30, 2017.
<b>FY17 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)</b>	Grant period ended on September 30, 2017. Submitted Final Performance Report on October 26, 2017. Submitted Final Reimbursement Claim on October 25, 2017. Grant funds continued Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations and Traffic Safety Educational Presentations.

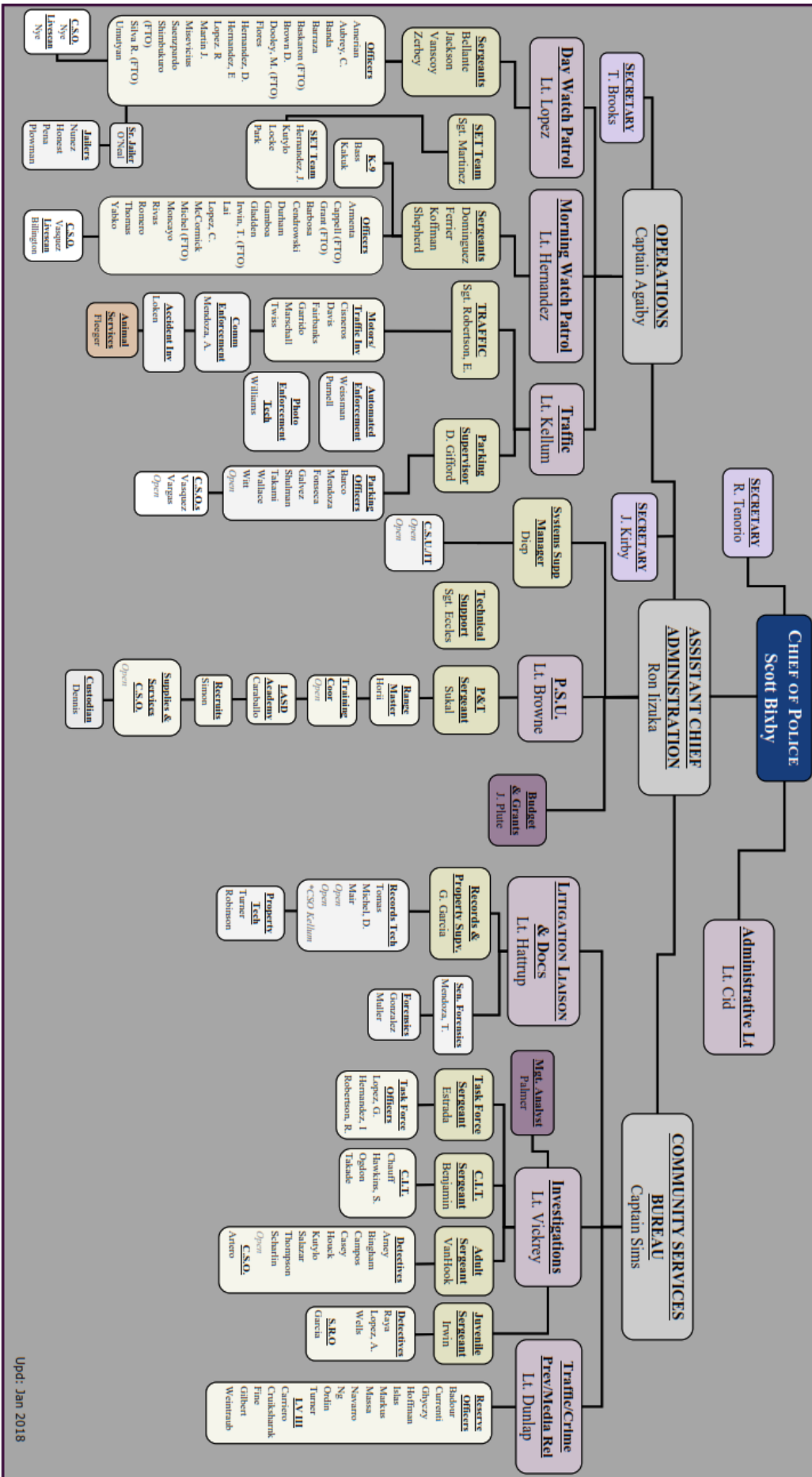
### Grants Applied

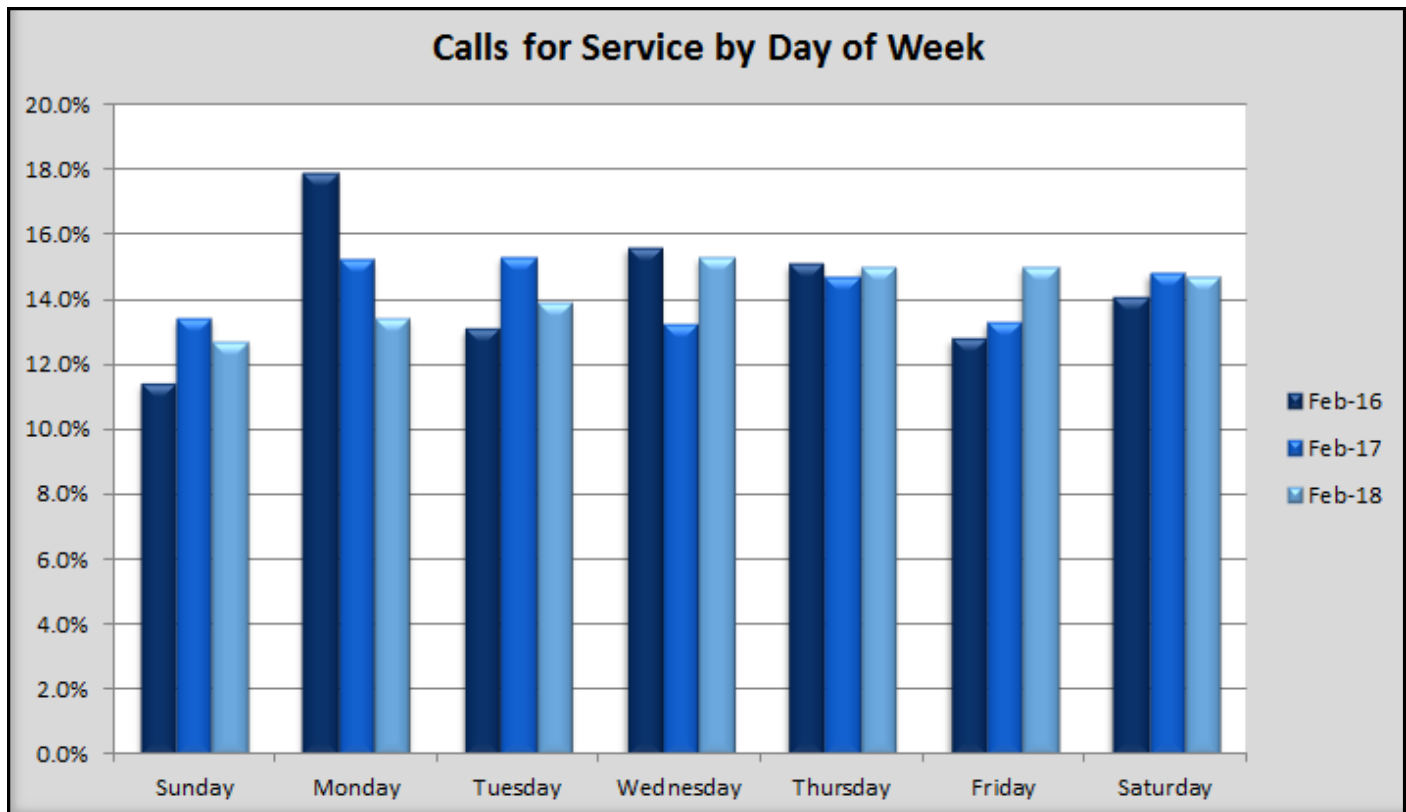

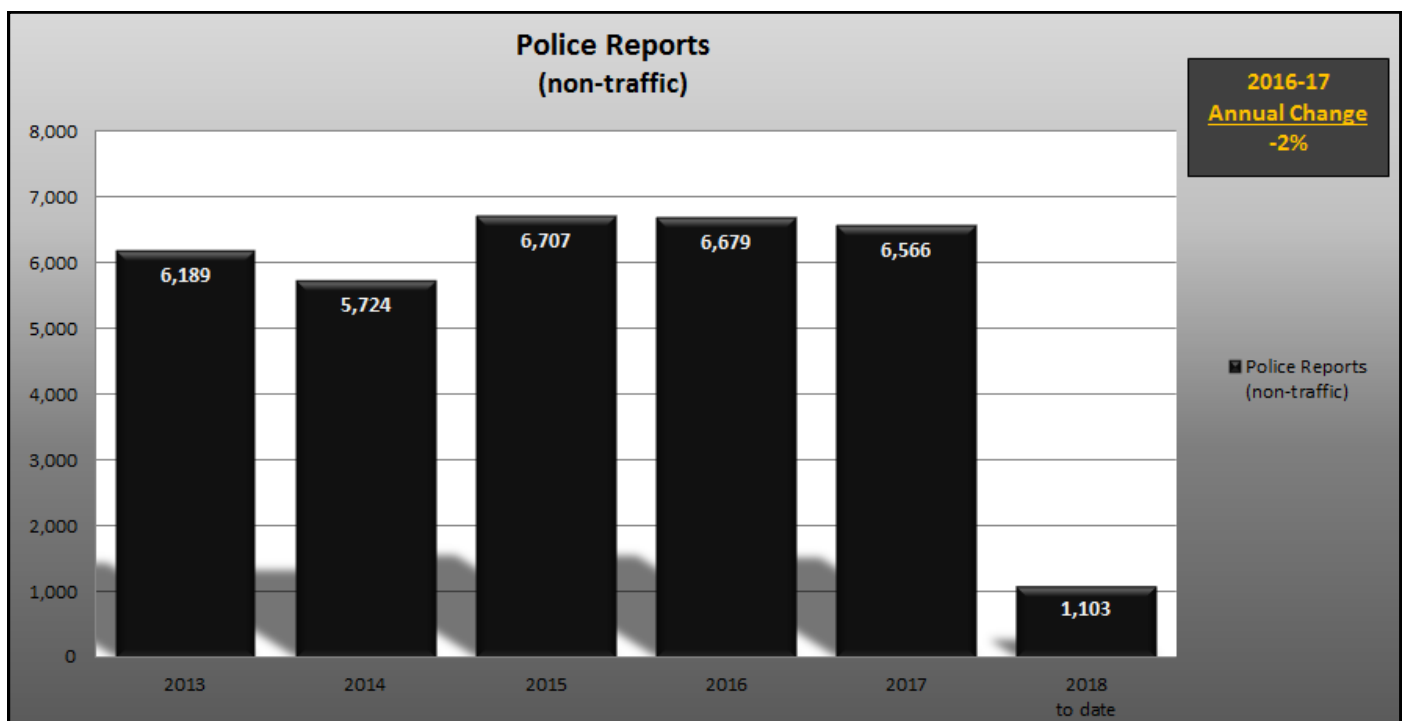


## CALLS FOR SERVICE BY DAY OF WEEK

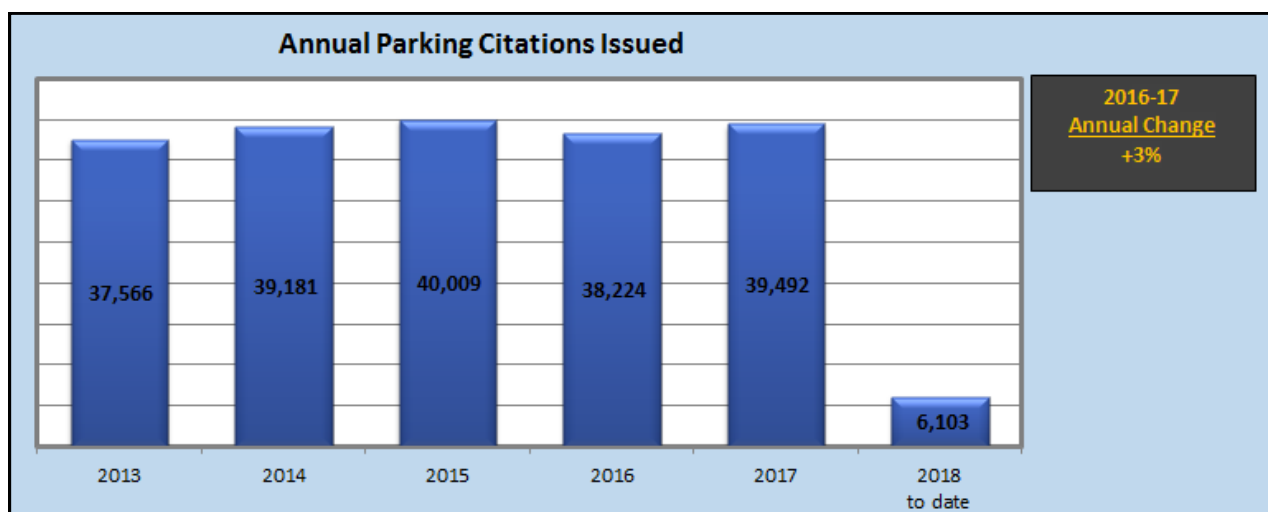
