Grants Awarded

FY16 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership	Awarded \$22,505.08. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests. Required to exhaust FY16 funds prior to using FY17 funds.
FY17 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs—Bulletproof Vest Partnership	Awarded \$9,225.79. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests.
FY17 Board of State and Community Corrections	Grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 was awarded in February 2017. Grant funds will be used to contract with local non-profit social service providers to perform additional outreach services for our homeless population and interface with our mental health evaluation team for the best possible solutions for each individual case.
FY18 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)	FY18 Grant in the amount of \$120,000 was awarded on August 25, 2017. The grant period is October 1, 2017- September 30, 2018. First Quarter Program and Financial/ Reimbursement reports are due by January 30, 2018. Requested grant funds will continue Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations, Traffic Safety Educational Presentations and Safe Routes to School education and enforcement.




CALLS FOR SERVICE/ POLICE INCIDENTS




CALLS FOR SERVICE BY DAY OF WEEK
















