**ASSAULT WITH A FIREARM SUSPECT ARRESTED**

On August 27<sup>th</sup> 2020, at approximately 1050 AM, Culver City Police Officers received a radio call of an assault with a deadly weapon that occurred in the 9200 block of Culver Blvd. The victim stated that the suspect pointed a handgun at him during a road rage incident. The victim provided a suspect description as well as the license plate number to the suspect vehicle. CCPD Patrol Officers conducted an area check and located the suspect vehicle parked and unoccupied in the Trader Joe's parking lot, located at 9290 Culver Blvd.

Undercover detectives established surveillance on the vehicle. At approximately 1700 hours, a subject matching the description of the suspect approached the vehicle and was detained without incident. The vehicle was searched and a loaded 9MM handgun along with a quantity of cocaine was recovered.

The suspect was arrested for PC 245 (c) (Assault with a Deadly Weapon) and HS 11350 (A) (Possession of a controlled substance).

The case will be presented to the Los Angeles District Attorney's Office for criminal filing consideration.
