PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION INFORMATION

With the upcoming presidential inauguration next week, the safety of our community is of top priority for the Culver City Police Department. We are aware of concerns from members of the public about potential armed protests throughout the country as we approach the presidential inauguration on January 20th. Many of the reported threats focus on federal courthouses and government buildings. While we are not aware of any specific threats or planned protests in Culver City, we will continue to monitor the situation as it develops. The Culver City Police Department understands the severity of the situation and is committed to safeguarding the lives and property of our community members. We want to reassure the community that we are prepared should any issues arise, and are collaborating with our local, state and federal partners.

The Culver City Police Department also recognizes and values the rights of all members of the community to peacefully exercise their First Amendment Rights and will ensure these rights and liberties are protected. The safety and protection of our community is our primary concern.
