**ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY**

On July 6<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 2309 hours, Culver City Patrol Officers were flagged down by a woman who stated that five males just attempted to rob her at gunpoint.

The victim told officers that she was standing in front of the ATM at the Bank of America, located at 3809 Culver Center Drive. An older model Toyota Corolla occupied by five Hispanic males drove alongside of her. The front passenger Suspect #1 (described below) pointed a black semi-automatic handgun at the victim and demanded her money. The victim told the suspects that she did not have any money at which point the suspect vehicle drove away towards Washington Blvd. and out of sight.

Suspect Vehicle: Older model, four-door, Toyota Corolla, black in color

Suspect #1: Male, Hispanic, 18 to 20 years of age, bald head, armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.

Suspects #2-#5: Male, Hispanics, 18 to 20 years of age.
