ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON (FIREARM)

Suspect: Male Black, early 20's, 5'6", thin build, wearing dark colored pants, red plaid long sleeve shirt.

Suspect Vehicle: Newer dark gray pick-up truck

Weapon Used: Unknown type handgun

On September 30, 2020 at 10:15 PM, Culver City Police Officers responded to the 11200 Block of McDonald Street regarding an assault with a firearm. Officers met with the victim who explained, he is a Culver City resident and was jogging on McDonald Street when he observed the suspect vehicle driving parallel to him.

The victim stated, the vehicle turned southbound onto Dawes Avenue and parked at the intersection. As the victim was running past the suspect vehicle, he observed the suspect exit the vehicle and stand in the center of McDonald Street and Dawes Avenue facing his direction. The suspect yelled at him about an iPhone. The suspect then displayed the silhouette of gun from underneath his shirt and fired two gun shots towards the victim. The victim was not struck and sprinted away from the suspect. The suspect drove away in an unknown direction.
