



FY19 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership	On September 24, 2019, awarded \$13,471.13. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests.

Grant funds are being to provide additional staffing to expand the Department's Mental Health Evaluation Team in coordination with the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health. 
