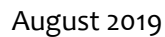

Grants Awarded

FY17 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs— Bulletproof Vest Partnership	Awarded \$9,225.79. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests. Must exhaust FY17 funds prior to drawing down FY18 funds.
FY18 U.S. Dept. of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership	On October 3, 2018, awarded \$19,148.75. Grants funds cover the one-half the cost of Department issued bullet proof vests.
FY17 Board of State and Community Corrections	Grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 was awarded in February 2017. Grant funds are being used to provide additional staffing to expand the Department’s Mental Health Evaluation Team in coordination with the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health. Our Mental Health Evaluation Team coordinates and collaborates with several local mental health providers to assist with and to provide additional outreach services for our mental health/homeless contacts.
FY19 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)	Awarded \$120,000 on October 1, 2018. The grant period is October 1, 2018- September 30, 2019. Fourth and Final Quarter Program Report and Financial/ Reimbursement Report are due by September 30 th . Grant funds are used to continue Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations, Traffic Safety Educational Presentations and Safe Routes to School education and enforcement.
FY20 California Office of Traffic Safety - Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)	Awarded \$100,000.00. Grant funds are used to continue Traffic Safety Operations; DUI Checkpoints, DUI Saturations, Bicycle and Pedestrian Operations, Traffic Safety Educational Presentations and Safe Routes to School education and enforcement.

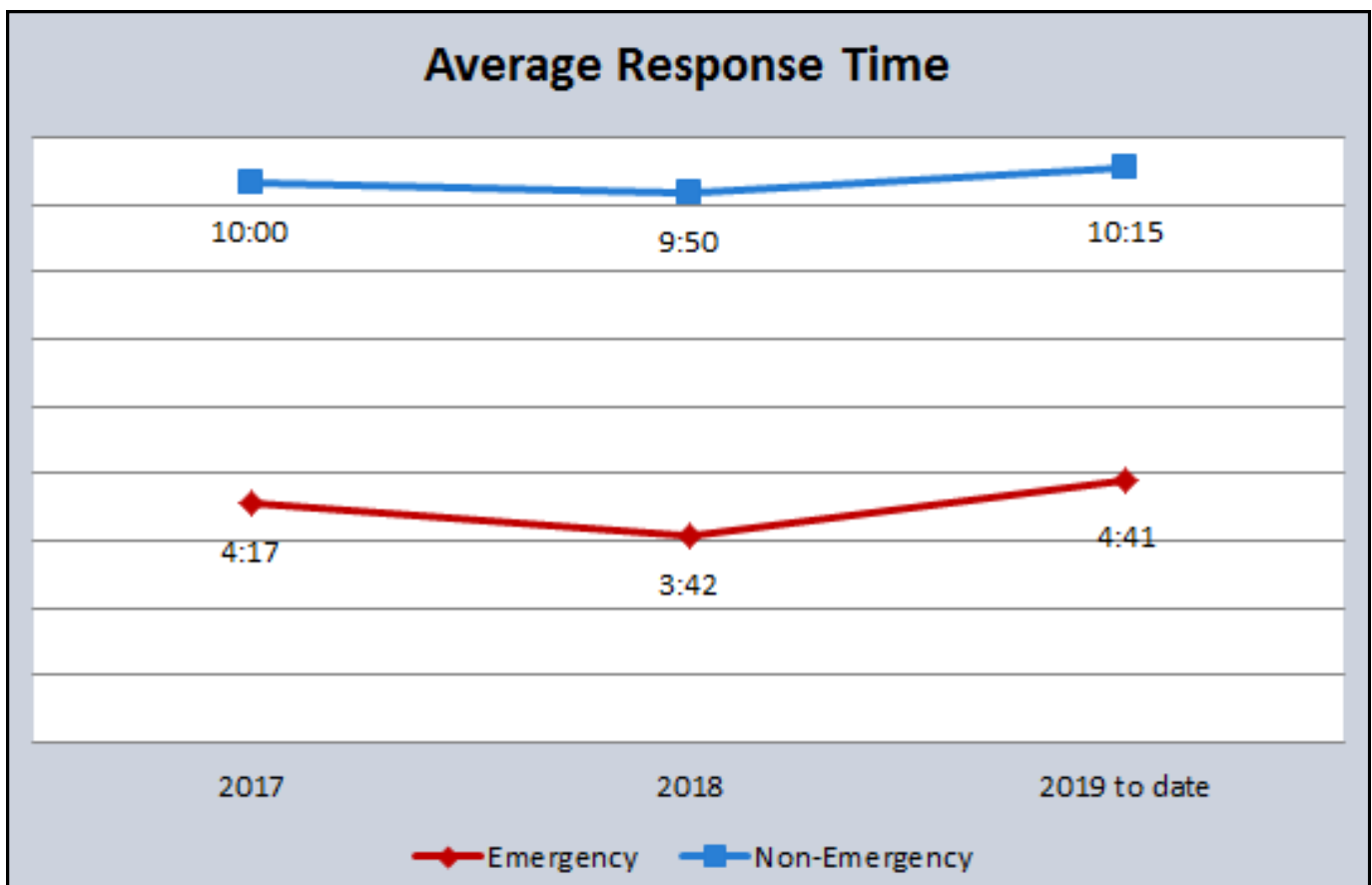

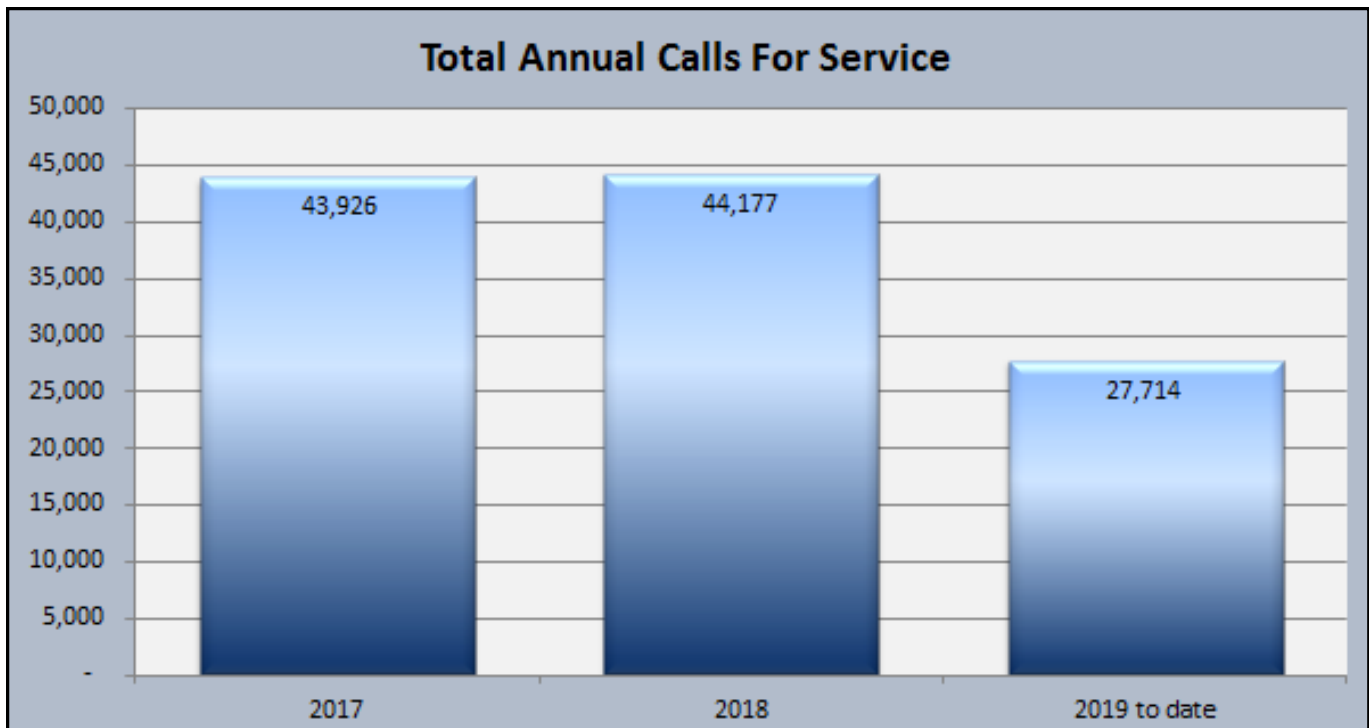

Average Response Time

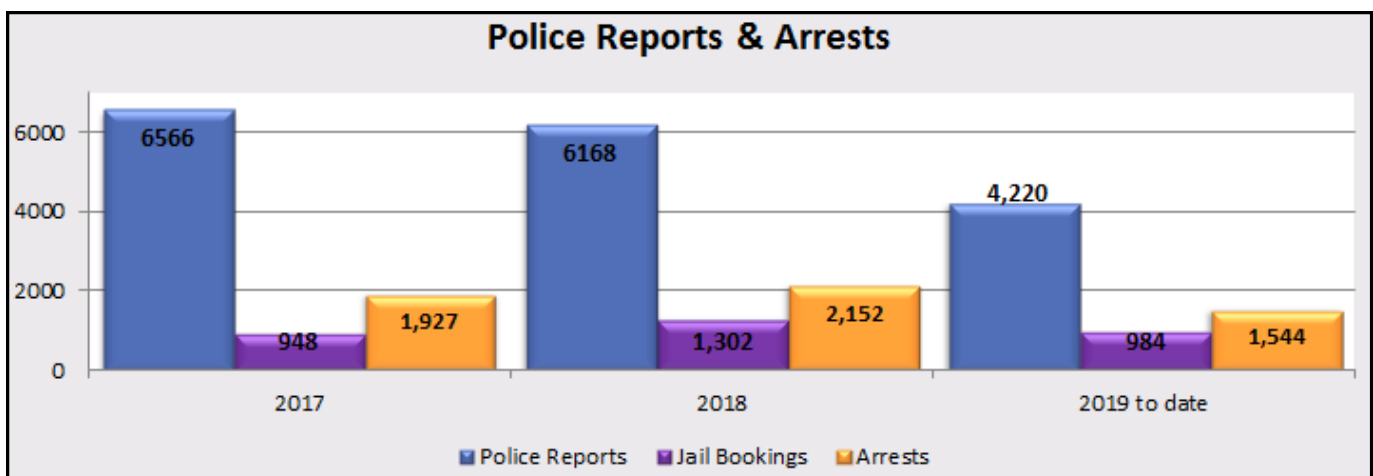

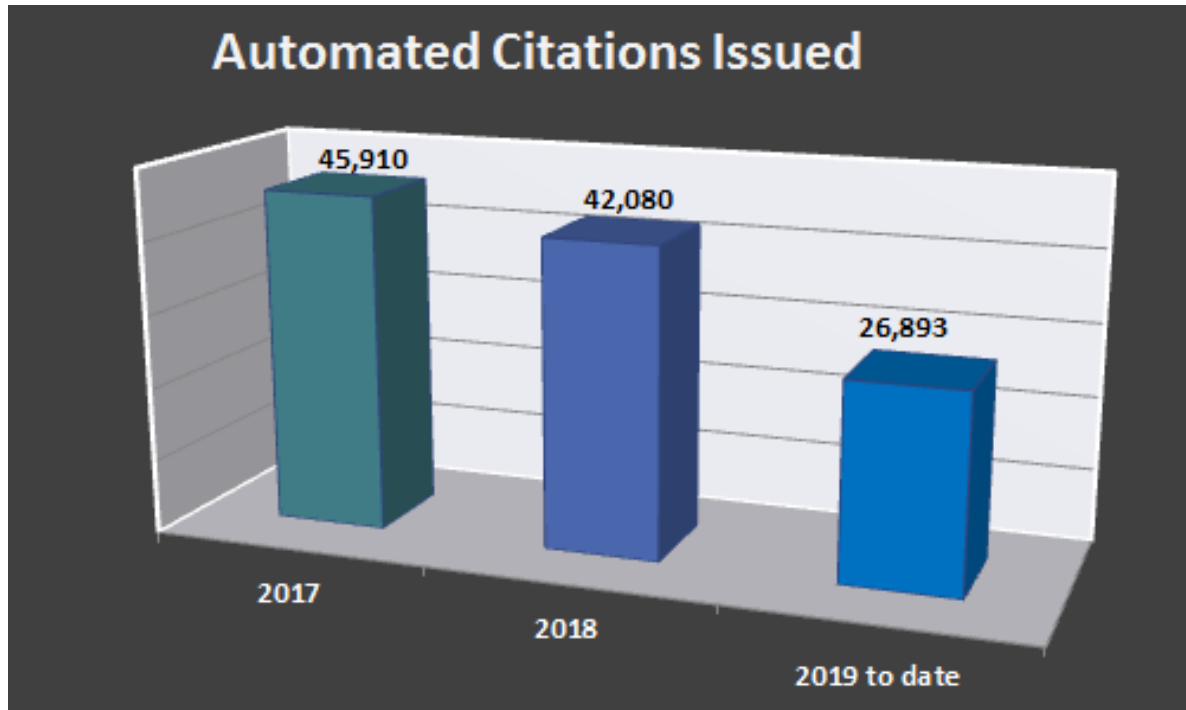

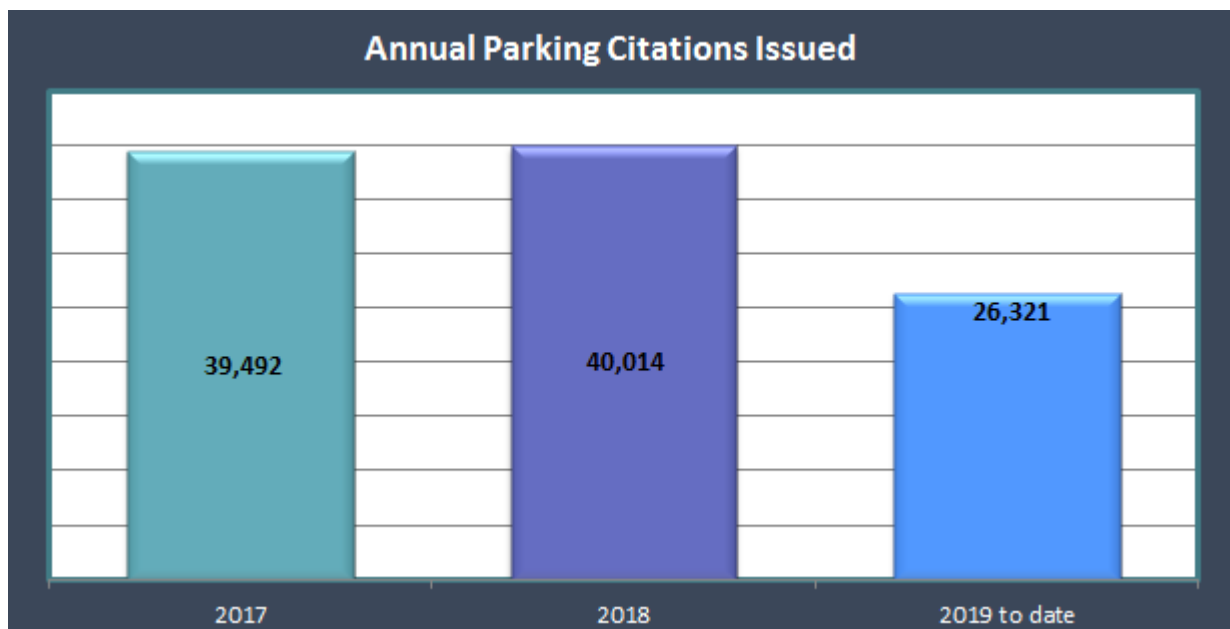
