








#### **Demographics of Police Department vs. Culver City Population**






#### Annual Average Response Time











#### Projected Annualized Change (2020-2021)








#### **Racial Identification and Profiling Act (RIPA)**

Among other things, data collected includes the perceived race or ethnicity, gender, and approximate age of person detained, reasons(s) for the detention, whether or not a search was conducted and the result(s) of the detention.

#### **Traffic Stop Detentions & Results (by Race)**





\*Property seized from a single detention can contribute to multiple categories.










2018-2020 Arrests by Race






#### 2019-2021 (YTD) Community Generated vs. Police Initiated Arrests


