







Arrest Breakdown by Race (2017-2019)






# Arrest Breakdown by Race (2020 to date)






# **2019 TOTAL ARRESTS COMMUNITY VS POLICE INITIATED: 2241**






#### **2020 COMMUNITY VS POLICE INITIATED ARRESTS: 985 TOTAL ARRESTS**







#### 2019 AND 2020 COMMUNITY VS POLICE INITIATED ARRESTS: 3226 TOTAL ARRESTS
