Armed Robbery

On Thursday, January 11, 2024, at approximately 8:38 pm, Culver City Police responded to a call for service of an armed robbery that occurred at the 12500 block of Washington Boulevard.

The victim reported that earlier in the day, at around 2:13 pm, he was riding his bicycle eastbound on the south sidewalk in the 12500 block of Washington Boulevard. As the victim passed a white 4-door sedan vehicle parked along the south sidewalk of Washington Boulevard, the occupants began to ask the victim, "Where are you from?" The victim did not respond and continued riding his bike away from the vehicle. When the victim approached the corner of Washington Boulevard and Neosho Avenue, the suspect vehicle pulled into the crosswalk, blocking the victim's path. A suspect (S-1) exited the front passenger side of the vehicle, approached the victim, displaying a firearm, and aimed the weapon at the victim's stomach area. The suspect again asked the victim, "Where you from?" and demanded the rear passenger side of the vehicle, approached the chain necklace from the victim's neck. Both suspects then returned to the suspect vehicle, and the vehicle fled eastbound on Washington Boulevard and out of view.
