CCPD Policy 1021: Uniform Regulations

Purpose:

This bulletin was created to provide training to CCPD personnel in regard to the existing **Uniform Regulations Policy**, namely, **1021.11(g), Load Bearing Vests: “POLICE” on back of the LBV**

Background:

Culver City Police Department Duty Manual section 1021.11 states:

Load Bearing Vests (LBVs) are authorized as an option to be worn by uniformed sworn personnel at the employee’s own expense. The LBV is to be worn with BDU pants and a BDU shirt or a pre-approved modified LBV undershirt. Sworn personnel are subject to the following conditions:

Section **1021.11(g)** further states:

“POLICE” is to be sewn on the back of the LBV centered across the upper back in all capital letters in plain two inch block font, silver in color.
